Accessing the Site



- You *get in* to the site using any web browser:
 - *Internet Explorer, Firefox, Chrome, etc*
- The address is:
 - <http://www.nobohandweavers.com>
- This allows you to look at *public* areas of the site
 - You cannot visit *private or hidden areas*.
 - You cannot make changes or add to the site
- You need to *login* to do more...
- Your *user_name* and *password* allows you to do more

Adding Content *Posting*




- To add content you need to log in and use the *Dashboard* the menu is shown on the left.
- Select *Users* to make changes to your profile and change your password
- Each selection has a *drop down* sub menu appropriate for the selection. The **Comments** is shown selected as an example.
- Click the arrow next to the selection to drop down the sub menu, click again to close it

Adding Content *Gallery*



1. Select Media
2. Select New from the drop down (not shown)
3. Click Select Files (depending on your system you will be able to choose the file to upload)

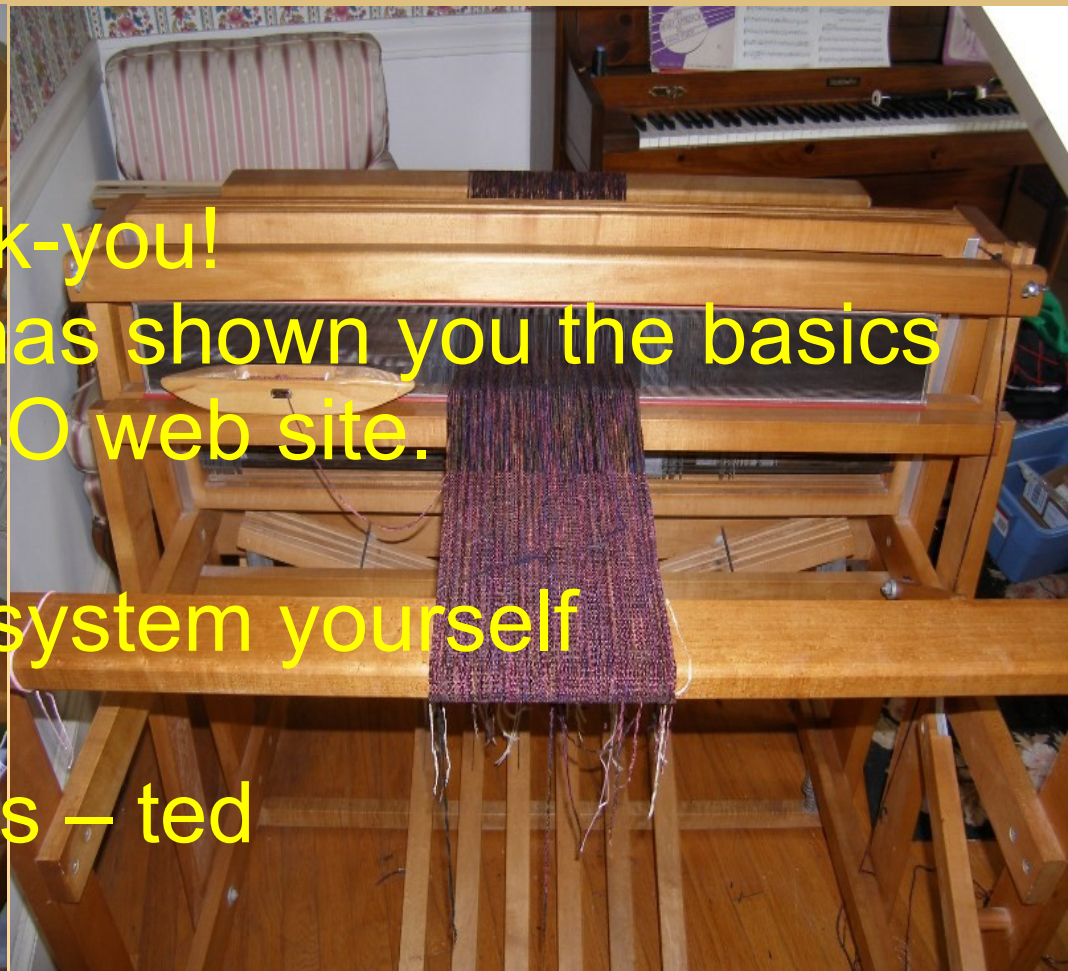
